Vocational English for refugees and migrants

On this course, learners acquire the language skills they need to work in accountancy and finance, and pass the exams which enable them to re- enter the profession they were trained for in their home country.

Many refugees and migrants are trained finance professionals but working in low level jobs in the UK owing to a lack of English language skills and confidence.

Acquiring vocation-specific language and passing a professional exam not only transforms learners' lives, but also those of their families. It enables them to make a greater contribution to their community, their workplace and their adopted country.

- ✓ Reading and interpreting financial language and documents (invoices, statements, reports, assets, liabilities, P&L, EBITDA, accounts payable and receivable, balance sheets, equity, reconciliation, accrual, depreciation)

- ✓ Applying grammar and structure for clarity in financial reporting
- ✓ Developing listening and speaking skills for workplace scenarios
